Project Summary

The LATIS modelling capability was used to produce a range of measures and indicators to inform land-use planning in the SESplan area.

This is a key example of how LATIS is being used to support Transport Scotland's planning reform commitments.

MVA Consultancy undertook a transport appraisal of the Strategic Development Plan for the The Strategic Development Planning Authority For Edinburgh and South East Scotland (SESplan).

MVA also worked with SESplan and SEStran to develop a set of transport proposals which

were required to support the development plan.

Current and future year planning data (in terms of housing and employment land allocations) was input to the model for all Scottish local authorities, along with national economic and population forecasts.

These were used to calculate future year socio-economic outputs which were then input into the transport model and used to forecast changes in road and public transport trip making and travel patterns.
